What is the Murray Bridge Learning Campus?

It's a partnership between TAFE SA, the Rural City of Murray Bridge, Regional Development Australia Murraylands & Riverland, Unity College and Murray Bridge High School. The Murray Bridge Learning Campus will arrange courses through a range of providers, including TAFE and universities. During 2018 we'll be talking to people in our region to find out what courses they want - and as soon as we have enough people, we'll run a course - from Barista to Bachelor!

What courses do you do here?

The MBLC can offer a vast range of courses from quick short courses to full degrees! We like to be responsive to the local need and have recently offered courses such as 'Beauty Basics', Barista training, Visual Merchandising and Certificate IV in Leadership and Management. We are happy to discuss any training needs you may have.

How do I enrol in a course?

Simply complete the form found at the MBLC webpage indicating the course you wish to enrol into and the MBLC staff will follow up directly with you on the registration process.

Are there any free courses?

All things of value have cost. While the MBLC will access funded options to reduce fees whenever possible, most of the training will have a cost to participants.

Can I pay my fees off in instalments?

In most cases, fees will need to be paid upfront before the class begins. The MBLC will advise you of the payment options and requirements upon registration.

When do courses start?

We can start training at any time of the year based on demand. We are highly flexible with our starting times/dates and will do our best to always have something new just around the corner. All courses require a minimum number of participants to run.

How do I find out more about a course?

You can complete the registration form on the MBLC website naming your nominated course and we will contact you with further details.

Can I hire a room?

In most cases – yes! We have a range of facilities available for hire and can accommodate up to 40 people in a classroom situation.
