Electric Car Charge Points

The Rural City of Murray Bridge have installed two state of the art electric car charge stations in the Local Government Centre car park in Seventh St Murray Bridge.

The charge points are capable of charging up to four cars at a time 24 hours a day. Four car parks have been allocated for charging electric cars with a 30 minute parking limit unless charging.

With the growing number of electric cars in South Australia, so are the number of charge points.

Residents and visitors to our area and travelling through our region can now access the new 22kW electric vehicle charge station.

Situated close to the Murray Bridge central business district shops, you will be able to spend some time shopping or having some refreshments while your vehicle is fully charged.



Council has provided this service to members of the general public at no cost as the majority of the power will be delivered from Council's solar power system situated on the roof of the Local Government Centre.

The electric car charge points demonstrate Council's commitment to the environment by reducing our carbon emissions and increasing the use of renewable energy sources.

The generic chargers are fitted with a type 2 charging socket which is suitable for all electric vehicles.
