THE OLDEST cricket club in the Murraylands, Monarto Cricket Club established in 1884, is seeking support for a new licence to secure the oval on Beatty Terrace, Murray Bridge.

The Rural City of Murray Bridge is proposing a ten year licence with Monarto Cricket Club Inc to allow Club members to continue using Homburg Oval as a home base.

Acting Chief Executive Officer Heather Barclay said public consultation for licencing the oval was a legislative requirement to ensure the community was satisfied with the use of the facilities.

“Monarto Cricket Club is a popular sporting body in this community,” she said.

“The Club is a member of the Murray Towns Cricket Association and took out the 2018-19 Premiers A Grade and B Grade division, back to back.”

The Monarto Cricket Club Licence public consultation opens today.
