**Council is helping to pave the road to success for the Thomas Foods International (TFI) meat processing plant rebuild to restore jobs in the local area and boost the region's economy.**

## CONSTRUCTION PROGRESS

Construction works are progressing on the west side of Mannum Road to create the TFI Link Road intersection that provides access to the proposed new TFI site.

The installation of underground stormwater infrastructure in this area has been completed, and installation of new pavement along Mannum Road is anticipated to commence from Monday 17 August 2020.

In addition, works on foundations for the new light poles along Mannum Road have also commenced.

Works along the TFI Link Road, which will connect the TFI site to Mannum Road are progressing.
