COMMUNITY members are invited to celebrate the launch of the Murray Bridge Wellbeing Hub by participating in a week of free activities and workshops.

The Wellbeing Hub will enhance and support community wellbeing by delivering a range of initiatives at a variety of locations in Murray Bridge and will be officially launched from 10am to 12noon Monday 20 March, at the Edwards Square community building now known as The Square.

Chief Executive Officer Michael Sedgman said he was proud to see the community inspired initiative come to fruition.

"Community consultation indicated overwhelming support for the establishment of a Wellbeing Hub and I'm happy to say that in partnership with Wellbeing SA and the Murray Bridge Community Centre, The Rural City of Murray Bridge is now able to offer this amazing new initiative," he said.

Wellbeing SA Chief Executive Lyn Dean said the Wellbeing Hub would support the physical, mental and social wellbeing of the local community.

"Wellbeing SA is excited to be working with The Rural City Murray Bridge to support wellbeing and encourage the community to stay healthy, active and connected," she said.

Murray Bridge Community Centre Coordinator Jade Porter said the Murray Bridge Community Centre would now operate from two locations – Beatty Terrace and The Square.
