THE COMMUNITY is being asked to provide feedback and help shape three key Council policies in The Rural City of Murray Bridge - Outdoor Dining, Event Traffic Management and Community Engagement.

Chief Executive Officer Michael Sedgman said policy amendments were made from time to time to keep up to date with evolving legislation and best practise requirements, along with community expectations.
