Mayor Lewis said regional Fringe provided an opportunity for the community to experience the best of SA arts and culture, although he was personally most looking forward to experiencing the local acts.

"Murray Bridge Fringe will be spectacular and I personally invite all residents and their families to come along for the free street party and enjoy what is sure to be an amazing night out," he said.

Sixth Street will come to life for the event with a stage at one end for acts and food vendors and a bar at the other.
