WELCOME to the Summer edition of our community newsletter: Connected Communities.


We look forward to a Summer season packed with many exciting events in Murray Bridge that will continue to revitalise our region as we continue our flood recovery.

2024 SANTOS TOUR DOWN UNDER

THE HAHN MEN'S STAGE 4: MURRAY BRIDGE - PORT ELLIOT will start at 11.10am in Bridge St, Murray Bridge on Friday 19 January.

After kicking off in Murray Bridge, cyclists will follow the 136.2 km route through Jervois, Wellington, Strathalbyn and Goolwa, before ending in Port Elliot.

Council is eagerly looking forward to hosting Stage 4 for the 2024 Santos Tour Down Under (STDU). It's our hope this stage will create an unforgettable experience as riders cross our newly restored historic bridge once racing begins, highlighting the stunning Murray River and our recovery after last summer's flood. Council anticipates that this event will attract visitors from far and wide, stimulating the local economy and providing invaluable support to local businesses. It is also an opportunity to highlight the community resilience, the beauty of the rejuvenated river and the opportunity for tourists to discover the Murraylands region for themselves.

DOGS OFF-LEASH TRIAL



THE FREEDOM TO RUN AND CHASE A BALL IS BEING TRIALLED AT AVOCA DELL AND TUMBELLA DRIVE RESERVES

THE NEW Dogs Off-leash Trial consultation is now open and Council are keen to receive community feedback about how well the initiative is working.

The Rural City of Murray Bridge initiative is underway as the result of a recommendation from a Dogs in Public Places: Off-leash Opportunities Study, undertaken last year as part of the Council's Animal Management Plan.

More off-leash opportunities in the community were supported by 83% of people surveyed in the Off-leash Opportunities Study, with a high preference for locations along the riverfront.

Avoca Dell and Tumbella Drive Reserves were initially identified as ideal locations for a trial. However last summer's flooding temporarily hindered access to these areas. With these reserves now accessible again, the Council is enthusiastic about assessing the public's reaction to the the opportunities available this summer.

Council is working to establish a network of suitable places where people can safely exercise their dogs off-leash, to improve the health, fitness and general wellbeing of our furry friends and their owners.
