BRIDGE Arts Incorporated is seeking to renew its lease for the next ten years, to allow local artists to continue to use a part of the Railway Control Building for community art activities.

The Rural City of Murray Bridge is consulting with the community to seek feedback on the proposed lease located in the Murray Bridge Railway Precinct.

Acting General Manager Assets and Infrastructure Deb Richardson encouraged residents to have their say about the proposed use of the site.

“We ask the community to share their views when we consider new leases for Council owned buildings,” she said.

“It’s important for the community to have a say in how these assets are managed and how their use benefits the local community.”

[Bridge Arts](#) has been operating from the Railway Control Building for the past few years.

The group meets regularly, arranges monthly workshops and holds exhibitions a few times a year, including for SALA (South Australian Living Artists Festival).
