A HELPING hand to make dreams a reality is available for projects that will benefit the community, in the latest round of Rural City of Murray Bridge Grants.

Funding opportunities are offered twice a year and community groups are encouraged to apply for the current round of Community and Environmental Climate Change Grants closing 4.45pm Friday 3 September 2021.

A variety of grants are available for initiatives that benefit the community including:

- Community Grants
- Sport & Recreation Facility Grants
- Environmental & Climate Change Grants
- Youth at Risk Grants
- Riverfront Activation Grants
- Building Enhancement Grants.

Mayor Brenton Lewis said the grants aimed to support community groups, clubs and other non-profit organisations by helping them deliver projects, events and other activities that contribute to the wellbeing and quality of life for Rural City of Murray Bridge residents.

“We see a wide range of projects and events delivered through this program every year, including environmental initiatives, sporting infrastructure, community events and many others,” he said.

“Now is an ideal time for community groups to consider initiatives they wish to pursue and apply for Council funding that would help - especially if they have not applied for funding previously.”

Community and Environmental Climate Change Grants are capped at \$5,000 each, with the recipients required to match the amount dollar-for-dollar or in-kind.

Applicants must be incorporated or have the support of a suitable incorporated body to receive funds on the applicant's behalf. Previous grant recipients must acquit their last grant before applying for another.

An information session for prospective applicants to gather information, ask questions, and discuss opportunities for grant funding, will be held 12 noon Wednesday 18 August upstairs at the Murray Bridge Town Hall.
