*BIG Little Art Fest* will fill the heart of Murray Bridge on Sunday 18th April 2021, when the Sixth Street arts precinct will again become a hive for the curious and creative!

A FREE event for all ages, the day will be packed with FREE art workshops, demonstrations, live music and roving entertainers, as well as colourful market stalls food trucks and more.

Celebrating the 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Murray Bridge Regional Gallery, this is a one-time bumper edition of the Gallery's annual free family event *Little Art Fest*.

Murray Bridge Regional Gallery Director and event organiser Fulvia Mantelli said the event also makes up for having to skip both *Little Art Fest* and *Sixth Street Handmade Makers Market* in 2020, and the festival's footprint is extending into the Gallery and the Town Hall auditorium.

"BIG Little Art Fest will offer creative workshops for all ages, from 3 to 103 year olds. There will be market stalls with handmade arts and crafts available ahead of mother's day. Also, the Gallery and The Station have collaborated to transform the Railway Terrace carpark into a hub of hip-hop music, dance and aerosol art for and by young people."

Festival workshops will include pottery, mosaics, botanical painting, cartooning, zine-making and weaving, for the little ones there will be chalk art and wearable art among others.

"You can just drop in to most of the workshops and you can book on the day for others. We're encouraging families to come early and make a full day of it. There really is something for everyone." She said.

"The Gallery will also be hosting two wonderful exhibitions: *Domestic Arts* by acclaimed SA artist Sera Waters, and *That Old Stuff* by celebrated regional-based artist Lyn Wood."
