Guidelines

Purpose of the grant

The Rural City of Murray Bridge is committed to providing support for local young people to achieve their goals in State or National sporting, academic or cultural pursuits.

All applications should meet these selection criteria and provision of the grant will be at the discretion of the Rural City of Murray Bridge.

Definitions

Sporting grants may be provided to applicants representing the Country or State in sporting competitions.

Academic grants may be provided to applicants representing the Country or State in academic competitions.

Cultural grants may be provided to applicants representing the Country or State in other competitions/events such as art, dance, music, singing or theatre.

Applicants

Application will only be received prior to the event; no retrospective applications will be received.

To be eligible for a grant each applicant needs to:

- Be a resident of the Rural City of Murray Bridge
- Attend a primary, secondary or tertiary institution full time and/or be 12 – 25 years of age.
- Be accepted to participate in a sporting, academic or cultural event representing Australia or South Australia.
- Must complete an application form
- Must be accompanied by:
 - Signed letter of notification (on official letterhead) from the respective State or National body or association stating the respective person has been selected to represent the State or Nation.

Grant amount

\$100 per applicant per year

If the applicant requires the grant funds to be deposited into an account they must provide

- BSB
- Account name and
- Account number

Other Information

- Complete all sections of the application form.
- Applications may only be eligible for funding once per year.
- It is up to the applicant to submit all required information.
- Keep a copy of your application and any supporting documents. (Council will not return or provide copies to you)
- Maximum Grant \$100.
