### Notes

- Burning permits can take up to 5 working days to be processed.
- The Council's Compliance Officers only inspect properties on **Tuesday and Thursdays between the hours of 8:00am – 12:30pm and 1:30pm – 4:00pm**. A Compliance Officer will contact you to arrange a time to inspect.
- The Permit Application will not be processed until the pile has been constructed and is ready for inspection. Any delays in constructing the pile may increase processing time for this application.
- The burning permit can be withdrawn at any time by Council, Police or Fire Officers if the fire is considered a health hazard or is causing excessive smoke or is creating a nuisance to other persons. If complaints are received due to smoke causing a problem/nuisance to others, expiations may be issued.
- You cannot burn on a declared total fire ban day for the district.
- **THIS IS NOT A PERMIT TO BURN.**

### Notes

- **No** burning on Sundays or Public Holidays
- Burning is only to be done between the hours of 10am – 3pm
- The fire **must be** extinguished by the time stated and not left smouldering.
- **No** treated or painted timber, plastic, rubbish, oil or tyres are to be burnt.
- **No** furniture such as couches, sofas or other household items are to be burnt.
- A four (4) metre clearance **must be** around and above any material to be burnt.
- One person **must be** present at all times to control the fire.
- Notify at least 20mins before burning – Murray Bridge Police (8535 6020).
- Notify at least 20mins before burning – Metropolitan fire Service. S.A (8204 3783 or 1300 737 637).
