Bridge Street and Sixth Street Revitalisation Design Project

Work on the detailed design for the Revitalisation of Bridge Street and Sixth Street commences.....

Council is pleased to announce that 'Jensen Planning & Design' have been appointed to assist Council in the development of the detailed design plans for the Revitalisation of Bridge and Sixth Streets, which is the next phase in realising Councils Town Centre Master Plan.

Work commenced on 1 May 2014, with the Project Team from Jensen Planning and Design meeting in Bridge Street with key Council staff to discuss, see and understand the nuances and character of both Bridge and Sixth Streets (in its current form).

The aim of the project is the development of design plans (ready for construction), that reinforce the connections between the river and town centre and the cultural hub of the town, with an overall focus on the revitalisation of Bridge and Sixth Streets, to make it an exciting, liveable, viable, activated and vibrant destination and centre for locals and visitors alike.

You may have noticed surveyors have been on-site since 5 May 2014 to capture the existing layout of the streets as a starting point. Concepts will then be developed based on Councils already adopted *Town Centre Master Plan* and *Town Centre Traffic Plan*. The concepts will then form the basis for discussion with the Murray Bridge community, traders, property owners and interested parties.

Further advice and fact sheets will be forthcoming on a regular basis over the coming months to ensure the community is fully informed regarding progress and also to be aware of key dates for comment.

The design project is expected to be completed in December 2014, and subject to funding for implementation, may commence in early 2015.
