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# Sixth Street Revitalisation

## Community Update Number 7 October 2015

### Project Background

The Revitalisation of Sixth Street is an exciting project for the Rural City, which builds on Councils adopted, 'Town Centre Master Plan and Urban Design Framework' and also the adopted 'Town Centre Traffic Plan'. At the 10 August 2015 meeting of Council endorsed the plans for the revitalisation of Sixth Street.

### Changes to Previously Scoped Project as a result of Consultation

As a result of the public meeting and one-on-one meetings with key stakeholders and the public, the following minor amendments and clarification to the previously scoped project were made:

Issue	Action Taken
<b>Parking</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Remove Loading Zones (3x) in Sixth Street North (adjacent to the Town Hall/Gallery) and replace with car parking spaces which can be temporarily "closed" by the Town Hall/Gallery for deliveries</li> <li>Parallel Parking in Sixth Street North to be retained</li> <li>Include "Time Limited" parking outside 'Mitre 10'</li> </ul>
<b>Security/Safe Environments</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Note that existing CCTV is operational</li> <li>Introduce additional CCTV in Sixth Street in consultation with traders and residents to ensure privacy is maintained</li> <li>Introduce a physical Security Surveillance Program in Sixth Street</li> </ul>
<b>Drainage</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Engineer has confirmed that the Drainage Capacity has been modelled to accommodate a 1 in 10 year overland flow and underground drainage system</li> </ul>
<b>One-Way Sixth Street South</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Even though it is physically possible to introduce two-way traffic to Sixth Street South – adjacent to 'Mitre 10', it was not approved as it will lead to unnecessary confusion</li> </ul>
<b>Access to Sixth Street</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Provide signage at Bridge Street to denote businesses within Sixth Street</li> <li>A limit is imposed on the number of "Road Closures" for Sixth Street for events</li> </ul>
<b>Cut "Red-Tape"</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Develop a Town Centre Management Plan in consultation with traders to provide an easier environment for traders to prosper, to reinvigorate the Town Centre</li> </ul>
<b>Management of Construction</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Develop a construction program/method in collaboration with traders/property owners</li> </ul>

### Funding Opportunities

In June 2015 Council's application for the 'Sixth Street Revitalisation Project' under the Planning and Development Fund for \$1,700,141 was approved.

Council has submitted an application under the National Stronger Regions Fund (Round 2), seeking \$1.7M. An announcement of successful projects will be made in December 2015.

### Where to from here?

Council will seek tenders for the construction of Sixth Street, and the outcomes of the tender process will be presented to Council. A further Report will also be presented to Council once there is an announcement of successful projects under the National Stronger Regions Fund (Round 2).
