Construction Update

The construction of the new underground stormwater drainage for the Revitalisation of Sixth Street is almost complete and the installation of the new concrete kerbing has commenced. Over the coming weeks the new concrete pavements will be installed in Zone 1 (the Southern end adjacent to Mitre 10 and the Marketplace) and Zone 5 (the Northern end between Fourth Street and Fifth Street).
