Construction Update

Despite some wet weather in recent weeks the team from 'Outside Ideas' have continued to make steady progress with the works on Sixth Street. Block paving of Zones 1 and 5 has commenced, starting with the feature paving for the new dish drains. The paving works will continue in these zones throughout September 2016.
