### Construction Update

Like much of South Australia it has been a very wet week in Murray Bridge, which has presented some challenges to the 'Sixth Street Revitalisation Project'. Despite the conditions the team from Outside Ideas have significantly progressed the block paving of the roads and footpaths in Zone 1 (the Southern end adjacent to Mitre 10 and the Marketplace) and Zone 5 (the Northern end between Fourth Street and Fifth Street).
