Construction Update

The new block paving of the road is well advanced in Zone 4 (from the Murray Bridge Hotel to the Town Hall). The team from Outside Ideas are showing great attention to detail with the paving patterns – in particular the Kanmantoo Stone dish drains will be a great feature of the Sixth Street Revitalisation project (see right).

Water main renewal works are also underway in Zone 2, together with the pouring of the remaining concrete pavements and laying of new block paving.

In the coming weeks you will also notice some of the new street furniture being installed, starting with the hardwood bollards. The work zones will also shrink in size as more of the street is re-opened to the public in preparation for the Christmas period.



Open for Business

All local traders will remain 'open for business' throughout the construction works, with pedestrian access to shops and businesses available at all times. The staging of the works also means that there is plenty of parking available for visitors to the Sixth Street precinct.
