

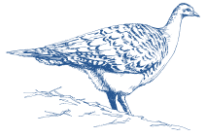

FERRIES MCDONALD ROAD REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT

Update Number 21

22 March 2013



Weekly updates will now recommence as part of Council's commitment to keep the community and key stakeholders informed of the projects progress.

The Chauncey's Line and Ferries McDonald Road intersection has now been completed, finalising the sealing of Phase 1 with line marking and signage to follow shortly.

Road Construction for Phases 2 of the project, covering the 5km section of Ferries McDonald Road from Garwood Road to the southern side of the Monarto Conservation is scheduled to commence next week starting 25th March 2013.



Native Vegetation has been pruned along Ferries McDonald Road to the Freeway in preparation for Phase 2 and 3 of the project.

Council is also undertaking routine road maintenance work at the Northern end of Ferries McDonald Road to ensure this section of road is safe for road users until it is upgraded as part of Phase 3.

Land Agreements along with State and Federal Government approvals are now in place. This will allow construction to continue through to the following financial year completing the project in early 2014 subject to weather conditions for sealing of the road.

Please note that a 40Km/h speed limit will remain through the Ferries McDonald Conservation Park until the pavement line marking and signage are in place.
