FERRIES MCDONALD ROAD REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT

Further to the recommencement of our Weekly Up-date last week, Council is pleased to advise that earthworks associated with Phase 2 of the redevelopment project commenced this week.

For reference, Phase 2 of the redevelopment project includes the section of Ferries McDonald Road, between the Garwood Road Intersection and the "S-Bend", adjacent to Monarto Conservation Park.



In addition to earthworks commencing, those living in close proximity to the road will be aware that native vegetation pruning in preparation for the roadwork's continues for the length of the road to the Freeway.

Signs as required by the Commonwealth Government, to alert motorists to the presence of Malleefowl in the area have also been installed at both the northern and southern entrances to the Ferries McDonald Conservation Park on Ferries McDonald Road. The signs currently

exclude a 60km/h advisory speed sign, which will be installed at a later date once the 'roadwork's' speed limits (40km/h) are removed from the portion of road through the Ferries McDonald Conservation Park.

Please note that a 40km/h speed limit will remain through the Ferries McDonald Conservation Park until the pavement line marking and signage are in place.
