FERRIES MCDONALD ROAD REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT

Preliminary vegetation clearance for Phase 2 and 3 within the road reserve is close to completion in accordance with State Government approvals.

The road construction for Phases 2 of the project, covering the 5km section of Ferries McDonald Road from Garwood Road to the southern side of the Monarto Conservation Park is well underway and shall continue through to the end of June 2013.



Our construction crew had a well-earned break over Easter, resulting in limited construction works since the last project update on the 29th March 2013.

Road users are reminded to continue to be vigilant within the construction zone and adhere to road works speed limits of 25km/h during the day (while works are underway) and 40km/h at all other times. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.

Please note that a 40K/h speed limit will remain through the Ferries McDonald Conservation Park until the pavement line marking and signage are in place in the coming weeks.
