# FERRIES MCDONALD ROAD REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT

## Update Number 24

12 April 2013



Work continues along Ferries McDonald Road for the 4<sup>th</sup> week of construction.

The road construction for Phases 2 of the project, covering the 5km section of Ferries McDonald Road from Garwood Road to the southern side of the Monarto Conservation Park is well underway and shall continue through to the end of June 2013.

Over the course of the next few weeks those property owners with direct property

access to Ferries McDonald Road (drive-way entrances), will be contacted by Council Officers to arrange a suitable time to meet and discuss the design of the new road as it relates to their property access and to understand existing access needs.

Road users are reminded to continue to be vigilant within the construction zone and adhere to road works speed limits of 25km/h during the day (while works are underway) and 40km/h at all other times.

Please note that a 40km/h speed limit will remain through the Ferries McDonald Conservation Park until the pavement line marking and signage are in place in the coming weeks.
