Major earthworks continue to the North of Garwood Road, in the land adjacent to Monarto Conservation Park. Crushing of the road base material is well under way and will be introduced to raise the road close to the finished level in the coming weeks.

Property owners with direct property access to Ferries McDonald Road are encouraged to contact Council if they have any concerns regarding access to their property. A Council Officer will arrange a suitable time to meet and discuss the design of the new road as it relates to their property access.



Major Earthworks continues to move forward North of the new road alignment adjacent to Monarto Conservation Park.

Road users are reminded to continue to be vigilant within the construction zone and adhere to road works speed limits of 25km/h during the day (while works are underway) and 40km/h at all other times.
