Council has installed signs to create a high level of awareness of endangered fauna in a number of locations along Ferries McDonald Road and Chauncey's Line Road to ensure motorists take care while traveling through this area.

Major earthworks continue to the North of Garwood Road. Crushing of the road base material is well under way and is being introduced to raise the road close to the finished level in the coming weeks.

Major earthworks continue to move forward North of Monarto Conservation Park re-entering onto the existing road alignment.
