

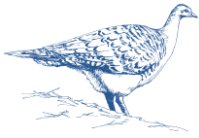

# FERRIES MCDONALD ROAD REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT

## Update Number 44

30 August 2013



The production of limestone rubble required to build the road pavements continues at the Council borrow pit on Chauncey's Line Road. A total of 90,000 tonnes of material will have been used on the road at completion.

Council has undertaken a design review adjacent the Monarto Conservation Park through to the Freeway. This review has resulted in a reduction of over 3,000 cubic metres of excavation representing a significant saving to the project.

Drainage culverts continue to be constructed with five of the eight culverts now installed between Garwood Road and the Freeway.
