Planting of native Acacia's has commenced using seedlings propagated from seeds collected within the Ferries McDonald Road Reserve by the South Australian Murray-Darling Basin Natural Resources Management Board.

This is in addition to Council's requirement to revegetate areas of redundant road reserves along Ferries McDonald Road. More native vegetation seedlings will be planted when the conditions are favourable.

The production of limestone rubble required to build the road pavements continues at the Council borrow pit on Chauncey's Line Road.
