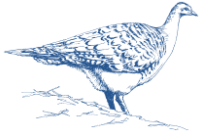

# FERRIES MCDONALD ROAD REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT

## Update Number 53

1 November 2013



Major earthworks have now been completed for the project with the removal of the final crest leading down to the Freeway.

A sense of excitement has been expressed by some residents with the opening of the new section of road adjacent to Monarto Conservation Park. Limestone rubble base shall now be introduced, raising the level of the road through to the Freeway ready for sealing.

Top soil is now being stockpiled along the old road reserve adjacent to Monarto Conservation Park ready for revegetation.

The project is on track to be completed by April 2014. Councils program is to seal the road through to the freeway in two stages with the first stage of sealing to commence in late December 2013.
