# FERRIES MCDONALD ROAD REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT

## Update Number 54

8 November 2013



The final crest leading down to the Freeway resulted in the excavation of approximately 2,000 cubic metres of earth which has been stockpiled along the old road reserve adjacent to Monarto Conservation Park ready for revegetation.

Over 20,000 tonnes of Limestone rubble base has now been crushed at Council's borrow pit on Chauncey's Line Road which is now being introduced to raise the level of the road ready for the first stage of sealing to commence in late December 2013.

Road users are reminded to continue to be vigilant within the construction zone and adhere to road works speed limits of 25km/h (while works are underway) and 40km/h at all other times.
