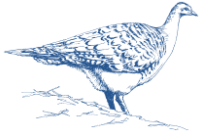

# FERRIES MCDONALD ROAD REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT

## Update Number 63

24 January 2014

Preparations are underway for sealing an additional three kilometres of Ferries McDonald Road. Council has programed with its sealing contractor to apply the final seal to this section in early February 2014, pending the availability of materials.



Council is also focused on the final 1.5km stretch of road to the freeway with construction of the final layers of road base and the installation of two drainage culverts. These drainage culverts will alleviate the flooding issues previously experienced in this area.

The production of limestone rubble to build the road pavement continues to be stockpiled at Councils borrow pit ready for installation.

Road users are reminded to continue to be vigilant within the construction zone and to adhere to road works speed limits of 25km/h (while works are underway) and 40km/h at all other times.
