The recent heavy rain late last week contributed positively to Council's construction works by providing much needed moisture to the final layers of limestone rubble base for the new road leading up to the Freeway. Council will focus its construction activities in this area in the coming weeks.



The sixth drainage culvert near Mountain View Road has been installed to accommodate overland stormwater flows and alleviate flooding issues in this area.

Road users are reminded to continue to be vigilant within the construction zone and adhere to the road works speed limits of 25km/h (while works are underway) and 40km/h at all other times.
