FERRIES MCDONALD ROAD REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT

Ferries McDonald Road is now starting to look like the strategic link through our Council for freight from Langhorne Creek to the Barossa Valley. Line marking, signage and road side markers have been installed along the newly sealed section of the Ferries McDonald Road.

The last drainage culvert near the Freeway has been installed allowing Council to focus on the construction of the final layers of road base ready for the final stage of sealing.

The top soil that has been stockpiled for revegetation of the old road reserve near Monarto Conservation Park is being prepared for the coming planting season.



Road users are reminded to continue to be vigilant within the construction zone and adhere to the road works speed limits of 25km/h (while works are underway) and 40km/h at all other times.
