FERRIES McDONALD ROAD REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT

Council is pleased to announce that the Ferries McDonald Road Redevelopment Project is nearing completion with the sealing of the remaining 4.9 kilometres of the road up to the Freeway. This work is expected to be completed on Saturday 5 April 2014.

Works commenced on the project at the intersection of Chauncey's Line Road and Ferries McDonald Road on 27 February 2012. Work included two complex intersections and 12.5 kilometres of road that required considerable cut and fill through crests and sags as well as private land that was required to be purchased and transferred into the ownership of Council as a road reserve.

Project updates shall continue until various close out items such as line marking, signage, road side furniture and the tidy up of road side batters has occurred.

Road users are reminded to continue to be vigilant within the construction zone and adhere to road works speed limits of 25km/h
