FERRIES MCDONALD ROAD REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT

The completion of this project (with the exception of some minor works still required) marked a significant day for the Rural City of Murray Bridge. The Ferries McDonald Road project has been in the works for several years and will now form a strategic major freight link between the Langhorne Creek and Barossa Valley wine regions.

During the coming weeks road side batters shall be tidied up and property owners with direct access to Ferries McDonald Road shall have their driveway entrances sealed for a short distance.

Preparations are underway for an official opening during the coming months. Council will inform residents once a date has been finalised.
