



FERRIES MCDONALD ROAD REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT

Weekly Update Number 6
10th April 2012

As we enter into our 6th week of construction, work continues at Ferries McDonald Road. Earthworks are well underway within the road reserve through the Ferries McDonald Conservation Park with the excavation of the first of three crests.

Work continues on the Chauncey's Line Road / Ferries McDonald Road intersection with pavement material being spread and compacted.



Road users are reminded to continue to be vigilant within the construction zone and adhere to road works speed limits of 25km/h during the day (while works are underway) and 40km/h at all other times. Council staff will assist road users around construction vehicles and in areas where vision may be restricted by current works.
