

FERRIES MCDONALD ROAD REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT

Weekly Update
13th March 2012

Work on the Ferries McDonald Road redevelopment is on-track and has now been underway for two-weeks.

Works are continuing at the Chauncey's Line Road Intersection, with top-soil now stripped and compaction of the existing base completed within the area formally owned by Peats Soils. In addition, a fence has been re-constructed to denote the new boundary between the new road alignment and Peats Soils land.



Over the course of the next few days the Council construction crew will commence work on building the road base within the same area.

Some native vegetation has been cleared at the Chauncey's Line Intersection in accordance with State Government approvals.

Road users are reminded to continue to be vigilant within the construction zone and adhere to road works speed limits of 25km/h during the day (while works are underway) and 40km/h at all other times.
