

# FERRIES MCDONALD ROAD REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT

## Weekly Update Number 7 17th April 2012

All major earthworks at Chauncey's Line Road intersection will be finalised this week. The first of two culverts (under the road) has been installed across Chauncey's Line Road intersection, just west of the new Kangaroo Road junction to ensure storm water is managed effectively.

The first crest located north of Chauncey's Line Road on Ferries McDonald Road has now been excavated to full depth, ready for placement of the new road base materials. Next week work will start on excavation of the second of the three crests.



Road users are reminded to continue to be vigilant within the construction zone and adhere to road works speed limits of 25km/h during the day (while works are underway) and 40km/h at all other times. Council staff will assist road users around construction vehicles and in areas where vision may be restricted by current works.
