



FERRIES MCDONALD ROAD REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT

Weekly Update Number 16 19th June 2012



Pavement works are now completed on Ferries McDonald Road between Chauncey's Line and Garwood Road intersections and at the new Chauncey's Line Road intersection in readiness for sealing later this year.

The final layers of road base will be placed at the new Garwood Road intersection over the course of this week and next week.

At this stage it is anticipated that the final sealed bitumen surface on the redeveloped sections of the road is expected to be applied during September/October 2012, as temperatures are currently too cold for sealing to occur now.

Road users are reminded to continue to be vigilant within the construction zone and adhere to road works speed limits of 25km/h during the day while works are underway and 40km/h at all other times. Council staff will assist road users around construction vehicles and in areas where vision may be restricted by current works.
