FERRIES MCDONALD ROAD REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT

Update Number 20

Council is pleased to announce that the sealing for Phase 1 of the Ferries McDonald Road Redevelopment Project is nearing completion. This includes the new intersections at Chauncey's Line and Ferries McDonald Road and Garwood Road and Ferries McDonald Road.

Line marking, signage and road side batters shall occur once construction starts on Phase 2.

Council has now gained the necessary approvals from the Native Vegetation

Council for the removal of the required native vegetation to build the remaining Phases 2 and 3 (Garwood Road intersection to the Freeway). This work shall commence in the week starting 18th February 2013.

Property owners with direct property access to Ferries McDonald Road (drive-way entrances) within the Phase 2 section of the road will be contacted by Council Officers in the coming weeks to arrange a suitable time to meet and discuss the design of the new road as it relates to their property access and also to understand existing access needs.

Road Construction for Phases 2 of the project, covering the 5km section of Ferries McDonald Road from Garwood Road to the southern side of the Monarto Conservation is scheduled to commence in late February 2013.

Please note that a 40Km/h speed limit will remain through the Ferries McDonald Conservation Park until the pavement line marking is in place.
