

FERRIES MCDONALD ROAD REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT

Weekly Update
20th March 2012



Works are continuing at the Chauncey's Line Road intersection with the first layer of road base placed and ready for compaction.

A large area of native vegetation at the Chauncey's Line Road intersection, which had been expected to be removed as part of the intersection works, has been preserved.

In addition, existing water mains have been relocated with minimal disruption to supply.

Moving forward into the next phase, construction work has started within the road reserve in the Ferries McDonald Conservation Park. Initial work has included clearing some native vegetation in accordance with Native Vegetation Council/State Government approvals.



Road users are reminded to continue to be vigilant within the construction zone and adhere to road works speed limits of 25km/h during the day (while works are underway) and 40km/h at all other times.
