

FERRIES MCDONALD ROAD REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT

Weekly Update
27th March 2012



Work continues at Ferries McDonald Road with earthworks now well underway within the road reserve through the Ferries McDonald Conservation Park.

Preliminary vegetation clearance has been completed through the Park in accordance with State Government approvals.

Members of the public will also note a stockpile of top soil along Chauncey's Line Road, which will be used at a later date for reinstating the redundant road reserve.

Road users are reminded to continue to be vigilant within the construction zone and adhere to road works speed limits of 25km/h during the day (while works are underway) and 40km/h at all other times. Council staff will assist road users around construction vehicles and in areas where vision may be restricted by current works.
