# FERRIES MCDONALD ROAD REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT

Weekly Update Number 14  
5<sup>th</sup> June 2012



Work continues on earthworks for the re-alignment of the Garwood Road and Ferries McDonald Road intersection. The construction of the final layer of road base has commenced at the Chauncey's Line Road and Ferries McDonald Rd intersection.

Preliminary surveying has commenced north of Garwood Rd with survey pegs being placed within the Ferries McDonald Road reserve. It should be noted that the pegging undertaken this week is to depict distance marks and not the proposed road alignment. While a day was lost due to 35mm of rainfall over the weekend, the project remains on target and within budget.



Road users are reminded to continue to be vigilant within the construction zone and adhere to road works speed limits of 25km/h during the day while works are underway and 40km/h at all other times. Council staff will assist road users around construction vehicles and in areas where vision may be restricted by current works.
