



# FERRIES MCDONALD ROAD REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT

## Weekly Update Number 10 8th May 2012



Earthworks at the third crest in from Chauncey's Line Road have commenced this week with work about to commence on the new and re-aligned Garwood Road intersection next week.

In preparation for works at the northern end of the Conservation Park (at Garwood Road), fencing along the adjoining properties is being adjusted in line with the new road and property boundaries (as per the drawing below).

Please be aware that as a result of works at the northern end of the construction zone, increased truck movements will be evident through Ferries McDonald Conservation Park, as carting of materials occurs between the 'borrow-pit' at Chauncey's Line Road and the works near the end of Garwood Road.

Road users are reminded to continue to be vigilant within the construction zone and adhere to road works speed limits of 25km/h during the day (while works are underway) and 40km/h at all other times. Council staff will assist road users around construction vehicles and in areas where vision may be restricted by current works.
