# FERRIES MCDONALD ROAD REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT

## Update Number 26

26<sup>th</sup> April 2013



Major earthworks are continuing along Ferries McDonald Road between Garwood Road and the 'S' Bend to the North, at Monarto Conservation Park.

In addition, to earthworks, fencing of the new road alignment at the 'S' Bend has also commenced (along private property boundaries only).

As previously advised, over the course of the next few weeks those property owners with direct property access to Ferries McDonald Road (drive-way

entrances), will be contacted by Council Officers to arrange a suitable time to meet and discuss the design of the new road as it relates to their property access and to understand existing access needs.

Road users are reminded to continue to be vigilant within the construction zone and adhere to road works speed limits of 25km/h during the day (while works are underway) and 40km/h at all other times.

Please note that a 40Km/h speed limit will remain through the Ferries McDonald Conservation Park until the pavement line marking and signage are in place in the coming weeks.
