FERRIES MCDONALD ROAD REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT

Weekly Update
5th March 2012

Council is pleased to announce that construction on the Ferries McDonald Road Redevelopment Project commenced on Monday 27th February as scheduled.

Work is currently focussed on the Chauncey's Line Road / Ferries McDonald Road intersection, with preliminary earthworks underway on the land that was formerly owned by Peats Soils on the south/west corner of the intersection.

At the outset and prior to commencing works, an intensive induction program was conducted for all staff and contractors, who will be working on the project to ensure that all staff and contractors are aware of and fully versed with the requirements for construction management and all environmental aspects, including those associated with native vegetation and malleefowl protection as prescribed by the State and Federal Government.

Signs are now in place indicating that the location is a work zone and reduced speed limits will apply.

As indicated in previous correspondence, the road will not be impassable or closed to traffic at any time during construction and property access will be maintained at all times. It should be noted, however, that at times, delays may be experienced by motorists, residents and property owners while construction is underway.
